EXPLORING SUMATERA TEXTILES AND CLASSY COFFEE SESSION AT TEMURUI HOUSE

Step into the living heritage of Sumatran textile tradition through a curated morning at Rumoh Temurui, a private gallery and textile collection space in the center of Banda Aceh. This unique session invites visitors to explore the intricate legacy of Sumatra's wastra (textiles). Starting with a warm welcome and a tasting of traditional Acehnese coffee and sweet traditional delicacies in a fashionable setting, the participant can have an enjoyable and pleasant feast experience. The session continues with a hands-on workshop on how to wear local textiles with elegance and meaning. It concludes with a guided tour of the special exhibition in the gallery, exploring the stories, influences, philosophies, and beauty of Sumatra's textiles.

ALTERNATIVE 1 AFTERNOON SESSION (13.30-19.00 PM, BY HI ACE, MINIMUMUM PARTICIPANT: 6)

ACEH ART AND CRAFT TOUR: CRAFTING HERITAGE: A JOURNEY THROUGH ACEH'S LIVING ARTS

This half-day social excursion offers conference participants a rare opportunity to step into the living world of Acehnese craftsmanship by visiting artisan villages and workshops in Banda Aceh and the nearby areas of Aceh Besar. The tour will stop in the village of Siem and Miruek Taman, where participants will visit a traditional songket weaving workshop and witness the intricate process of creating handwoven textiles with shimmering gold and silver threads, a proud cultural legacy passed down through generations of Acehnese women. Along the way, the tour will stop at a gold embroidery (*kasab*) workshop, where artisans embellish fabrics for ceremonial attire, wedding garments, and sacred objects using techniques that reflect Aceh's Islamic aesthetics and royal history. This immersive experience highlights the artistic mastery of rural artisans and celebrates the resilience and preservation of intangible heritage in post-conflict and post-tsunami Aceh. The tour concludes with a relaxing stop in Banda Aceh's souvenir district, where guests can browse and shop for locally made crafts.

ALTERNATIVE 2 AFTERNOON SESSION: (16.30-18.30 PM)

FOOTSTEPS THROUGH PEUNAYONG: A WALKING TOUR OF BANDA ACEH'S CULTURAL CROSSROADS

This social afternoon session offers an immersive walking tour through Peunayong, one of Banda Aceh's most vibrant, diverse and historically significant districts, inviting participants to experience the living tapestry of cultures, architecture, and daily life that defines the city's identity. Tracing the path along the historic Krueng Aceh River, once a lifeline of trade and scholarship during the Aceh Sultanate, the tour unfolds through Peunayong's atmospheric streets, where layers of Chinese, Acehnese, and colonial heritage coexist. We will continue by exploring *pasar*, a local market, and a sensory journey through the colors, aromas, and textures of Acehnese life—from tropical produce and traditional snacks to ritual items and everyday wares. The experience culminates in a coffee cupping session at one of Banda Aceh's finest specialty cafés, where guests will not only sample the region's world-famous Gayo coffee, but also learn about the deep cultural significance of coffee in Acehnese society.
